3. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000/- per month subject to maximum of Rs. 50,000/-.
4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board (Amended Rule 15.11).

Provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws for adherence:-

1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. ~~No separate fee of admission or other fee for~~ gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
2. The school should not use the activities for ~~commercialization~~:
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a ~~community service~~ and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any ~~form~~.
 - b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school /society has not entered into any such contract to use name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding ~~commercialization~~ & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for ~~any other board~~ except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
5. ~~Admission in the school~~ is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination Bye-laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation Bye-laws.
6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from ~~sexual harassment~~ at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame ~~rules~~ for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye-laws. Further, ~~contract~~ will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the State/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
8. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, ~~staff and service conditions~~ of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.







The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary and Senior Secondary School Examinations and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII: -

4. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
5. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X/XII Examinations from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to *suo moto* withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
6. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
